



How to Register and Subscribe to the current Weather Tipping season

1. Go to the new Weather Tipping website <http://tipping.amos.org.au/> and click "Join Up"

Welcome to the AMOS Weather Tipping Competition

This is a special AMOS event where you can test your weather forecasting skills for different locations around Australia.

The competition will follow the familiar format of a regular AFL football tipping competition but instead of winners, we're looking for your predictions of minimum temperature, maximum temperature and rainfall. Prizes will be awarded to the players with the lowest overall errors for each category at the end of the home and away season.

In addition, the top eight players at the beginning of the finals period will enter the playoffs for the premiership!

Rules

1. Forecasts are required for **minimum temperature**, **maximum temperature** and **rainfall**

| | |
|---------------------|---|
| Maximum Temperature | Measured from 9am of forecast day to 9am following day |
| Minimum Temperature | Measured between 9am previous day and 9am forecast day |
| Rainfall | Measured between 9am forecast day and 9am following day |

2. Forecasts are to be made for Saturday and Sunday
3. No forecasts will be permitted after 8pm AEST Friday (10pm NZEST, 7:30pm ACST, 6pm AWST)
4. Temperatures selected from the nearest whole degree Celsius and rainfall is selected from certain ranges.

2. Enter your First Name, Last Name and your email address. This address is where all correspondence will be sent. Once entered now hit "sign up"

Join The Weather Tipping Competition

As with previous years, signing up for this year's competition is free and open to everyone. We have streamlined the sign up process as all that you need to do is fill out the details below. Instructions on how to activate and login to your Weather Tipping account will then be forwarded to your nominated email address.

4. Now *login* to the weather tipping page with your email address and temporary password

5. Account login is now successful. Notice the menu on the right hand side. To start forecasting for the current season you need to click on the "*Manage Account*" link under "*User Menu*"



6. Under the Manage Account console, you can change your user details (upload a profile picture and change your password), and request the AMOS extras be enabled (see step 10).

7. To start forecasting for the current season, click on "*Subscribe to the current season*"



8. Now click “*subscribe*”. You are now ready to submit your weekend forecasts which can be done by clicking on “*Make a forecast*” under the “*Weather Tipping*” console (right hand side).



9. The season Fixture, Results, Ladder and Finals pages can also be found under the “*Weather Tipping*” console

10. Activating the **AMOS Extras** for this site can be done through the “*Manage Account*” console. If you have an AMOS membership click (1) or if you want an AMOS membership click (2). To visually see your performance (once your AMOS membership has been verified by the administration team), simply click (3).
